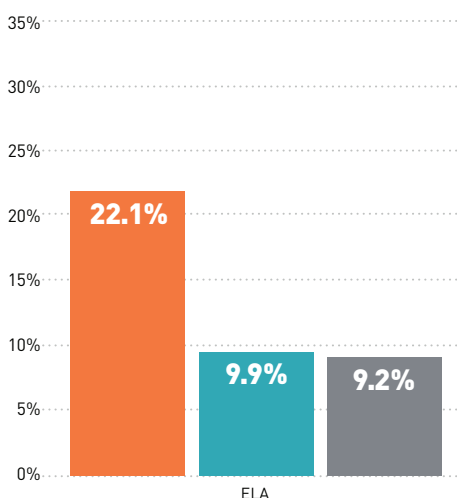

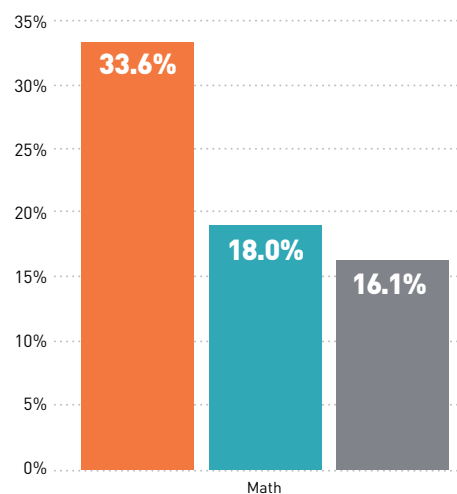
2017-18 ELA PERFORMANCE, ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS
